

When you venture out, the new Kidbrooke Station is on your doorstep and offers a swift commute to Greenwich and Central London.







Wander across the atmospheric expanse of green space at the village's heart where, each spring, thousands of runners from all over the world gather for the start of the London Marathon.



You wake up wondering what you're going to do today. Fortunately, Kidbrooke Square offers a world of choice and variety close by.






From Kidbrooke station






